This declaration of consent is a mandatory requirement for participation. An incomplete or false declaration will result in exclusion.

Any changes in relation to custody of the said child (e.g. through withdrawal, adoption or termination by court ruling) must be reported immediately and will usually result in the termination of the declaration of consent and the exclusion of further participation as a parent or legal guardian of said child in the German EasyPASS-RTP programme. A new application can be submitted for readmission.

Conditions of participation for children aged 12 years and over in the EasyPASS-RTP programme



- Participation in EasyPASS-RTP is subject to the following conditions
 - a) Your child meets the entry requirements in accordance with Article 6 (1) of the Schengen Borders Code (Regulation (EU) 2016/399).
 - b) Your child does not pose a threat to public safety or order.
 - c) Your child's travel document and, where applicable, your child's visa, long-stay visa or residence permit are valid and not false, counterfeit or forged, and the document has not been misused in any way.
 - d) You can prove or justify your child's need or intention to travel frequently or regularly.
 - e) You demonstrate your integrity and reliability – in particular, you can prove that you lawfully used any visas or LVTs (Limited Territorial Validity visas) granted to your child in the past – as well as provide evidence of your financial situation in your country of origin and proof of your honest intention to leave the territory of member states before the end of your authorised stay.
 - f) You justify the purpose and circumstances of the intended stays.
 - g) You have sufficient means of subsistence both for the duration of your child's intended stay and for your child's return to your country of origin or residence, or you are in a position to acquire such means lawfully.
- Your child's participation in EasyPASS-RTP may be revoked if these conditions are not met. Participation may also be revoked if you provide false, incorrect or incomplete information.

Consent for participation of children 12 and over in the EasyPASS-RTP programme and for collection and processing of their personal data

- I hereby voluntarily participate in the EasyPASS-RTP programme for registered travelers
- I consent to the collection of the personal data displayed in my child's valid, machine-readable travel document (electronic passport and any existing visa or residence permit) as well as the information I have submitted in the attached application, and further consent to the storage of this data in an EasyPASS-RTP database, where it may be used for processing my child's application.
- I may revoke my child's membership of the EasyPASS-RTP programme at any time with immediate effect without giving any reason, and without incurring any penalties as a result of this withdrawal. My child's data will then be irrevocably deleted from the EasyPASS RTP database. If my child's personal details are stored on the Entry/Exit System (EES) for the European Union, any remark noting my child's membership of the German EasyPASS-RTP programme will also be removed from his or her personal file.
- By participating in EasyPASS-RTP, I hereby consent to the collection and processing of my child's personal data, in particular to having this information checked using databases that the Federal Police maintains to fulfil its responsibilities or for which the Federal Police is authorised to access (e.g. the Central Register of Foreign Nationals and National Visa Database, as well as, where applicable, the European Visa Information System (VIS), the Visa Warning Database, the German police information system INPOL, the Schengen Information System (SIS), INTERPOL's Stolen and Lost Travel Documents database (SLTD), and the Federal Police's case processing system). The Federal Police's checks will take in account any refused entry or overstaying of time allowed in Germany.

European Entry/Exit System

- The European Entry/Exit System (EES) is currently being set up in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2017/2226. Personal data from non-EU citizens entering the Schengen Area for a short stay is recorded in a personal file. This applies regardless of participation in EasyPASS-RTP. The launch date will be announced in the Official Journal of the European Union in accordance with Article 66 of Regulation (EU) 2017/2226. The launch date for the EES will also be published on the website www.easypass.de.
- If my child's personal details are stored on the EES for the European Union pursuant to Art. 2(1) of Regulation (EU) 2017/2226 in conjunction with Art. 6a(1) of Regulation (EU) 2016/399, I hereby consent to a note being made on my child's personal EES file of his or her membership of the German EasyPASS-RTP programme once the EES has been officially launched, in accordance with Art. 6, 16 and 17 of Regulation (EU) 2017/2226.
- Following the start of operations for the EES, my child's data stored in the EasyPASS-RTP database may be used at all border crossings in Germany to enable him or her to pass through border controls without being subject to the checking criteria set out in Article 8(3)(a)(iv) and (v) of Regulation (EU) 2016/399 of the Schengen Borders Code (SBC).

Duration and retention periods

- Until the EES is launched, my child's EasyPASS-RTP membership is valid until his or her travel document expires. My child's personal data will be stored and processed until the aforementioned date.
- Once the EES is in operation, my child's EasyPASS-RTP membership, in accordance with Art. 8d para. 5 of Regulation (EU) 2016/399, will be valid for a maximum of one year or until the expiry date of his or her travel document, multiple-entry visa, long-stay visa or residence permit, whichever expires first. Membership may be extended for a maximum of five more years or until the expiry date of his or her travel document, multiple-entry visa, long-stay visa or residence permit, whichever expires first.
- The extension can only be granted in the last 90 days of the membership period at a Federal Police registration office or via border control. Membership eligibility is reviewed annually by border control and the Federal Police registration office using the latest data. The annual review is usually carried out within 90 days prior to the expiry of one year after the last review. If the review does not occur within this period, my child's participation in the programme will automatically end. It is possible to be readmitted to EasyPASS-RTP.

- The Federal Police will use the personal data provided by EasyPASS-RTP applicants and members to carry out measures required for the programme. Data no longer required for the programme will be deleted immediately.
- As soon as membership ends, or in the event the programme is discontinued, all data stored relating to your child's EasyPASS-RTP membership will be immediately deleted or anonymised for statistical purposes so that it is no longer possible to link the data to the person in question
